Since we last met to discuss a resident first approach to local planning, I know there's been an enormous amount of effort, enthusiasm and hard work applied to considering the best and most appropriate approach for your towns and villages. At our first meeting I emphasised that support is available from Cheshire East to prepare neighbourhood plans and that we were seeking to establish a group of 'front runners' - groups ready to go now and get a neighbourhood plan up and running as soon as possible. Following our meeting, we received some thirty two expressions of interest to prepare neighbourhood plans, an absolutely fantastic response! And a great testament to the appetite of communities in Cheshire East to take responsibility for their own futures.

Within this group nine communities have now submitted their neighbourhood area applications. This is the first formal stage of the process and reaching this point is a real milestone; that you've submitted your application is a testament to just how ready you are to progress quickly. And on that basis, I'd like to confirm that you will form part of the front runner group of neighbourhood planners in Cheshire East. The full group is:

- Stapeley and District


